



A Word About Trauma...

Trauma and associated words are being used more now than ever. Do we know the origins of these words? Are their meanings different now than when they were first used? Each week we will explore a trauma-associated word's origins, meanings and evolution.

Hyperarousal [hi"per-ah-row'zal] (Noun)

Merriam-Webster defines this as excessive arousal: an abnormal state of increased responsiveness to stimuli that is marked by various physiological and psychological symptoms (such as increased levels of alertness and anxiety and elevated heart rate and respiration). It is also one of three sets of criteria used to diagnose post-traumatic and acute stress disorder. Symptoms of hyperarousal include exaggerated startle response, disturbed sleep, difficulty in concentrating or remembering, and excessive vigilance.

Nekaneet First Nation is a Cree nation located in the Cypress Hills in southwest Saskatchewan and has a population of approximately 460 members. Nekaneet and his followers decided to stay in their ancestral land and refused to relocate. All K – 12 students attend school in Maple Creek. In January 2023, Nekaneet teamed up to create the Wiyotisiwin Investment Management Company (the first Indigenous-owned investment firm in Canada) to have more control over its trust investments.
