**Finance Council Opportunity**

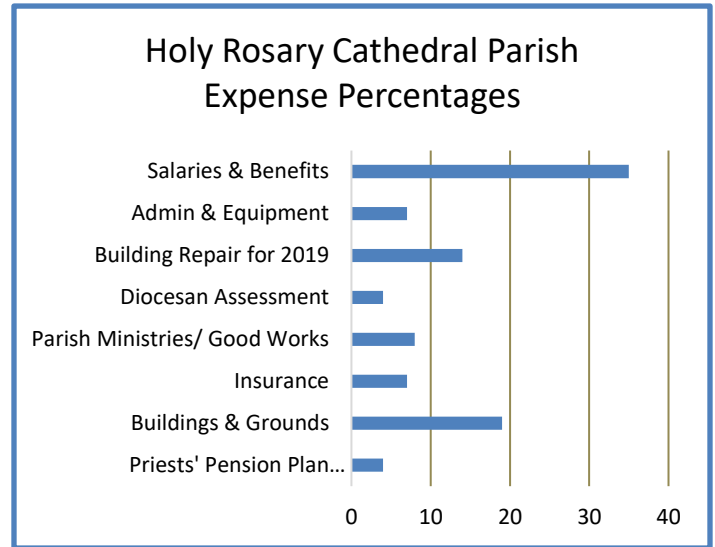
We are happy to announce that parishioner **Ann Gagnon** is joining the Holy Rosary Parish Finance Council.

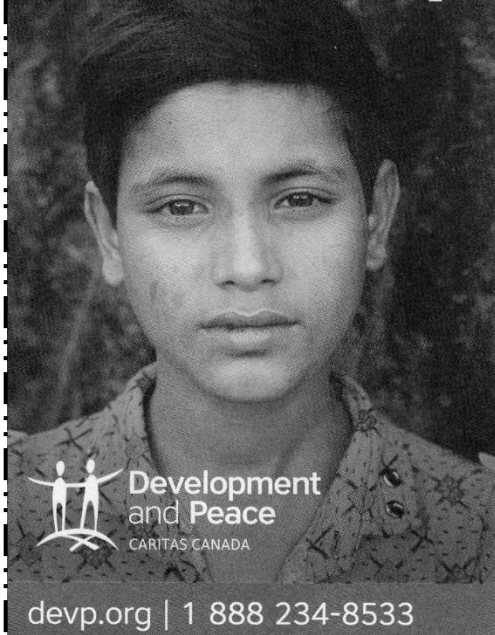

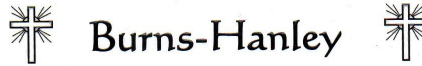
