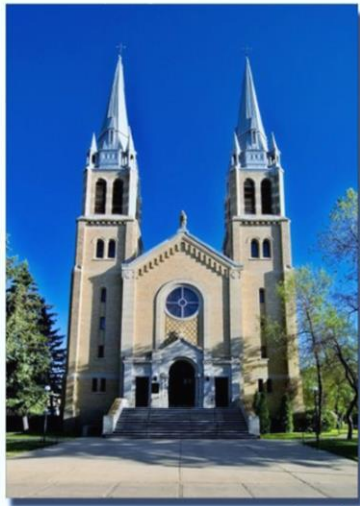

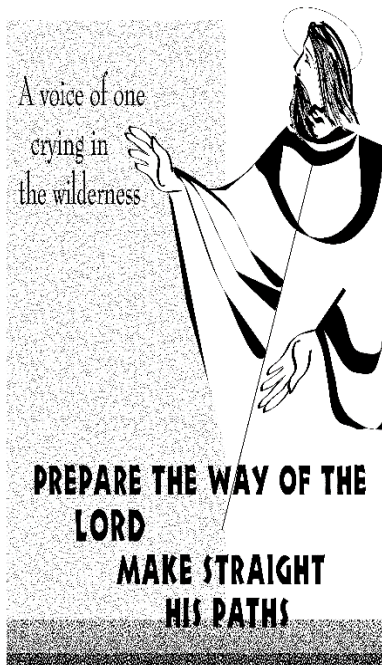

On 12 December, Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas, the Church in Canada celebrates the National Day of Prayer in Solidarity with Indigenous Peoples. This year, we take a moment to recall the Holy Father's Penitential Pilgrimage to Canada in July 2022, and in particular his words of prayer offered at Lac Ste. Anne:

"Lord, as the people on the shores of the Sea of Galilee were not afraid to cry out to you with their needs, so we come to you, Lord ... with whatever pain we bear within us. We bring to you our weariness and our struggles, the wounds of the violence suffered by Indigenous brothers and sisters. In this blessed place, where harmony and peace reign, we present to you the disharmony of our experiences, the terrible effects of colonization, the indelible pain of so many families, grandparents and children. Lord, help us to be healed of our wounds. We know, Lord, that this requires effort, care and concrete actions on our part; but we also know that we cannot do this alone. Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

A big, big thanks to all who donated towards the Downtown Lunch our parish served on Saturday, December 2, at First Baptist Church. Your generosity, added to the table-rental fees we received from the Treasure Trove event on November 25, came to a little over \$2000, twice for what we had hoped! We were able to prepare 200 lunches at a cost of \$1000 and purchased items of basic sanitary necessities (plus warm socks!) to set out on the "give-away" table for those who came to the lunch that day. AND we have the start of a "bank account" for future social justice projects. As Bernadette said from her sick-bed, where she is recovering from back surgery, "our parish ROCKS!"

Thanks to Bernadette's leadership, dynamic energy, and early planning, we had enough volunteers to help at both events. A very special thanks to all who baked the muffins, those who shopped for the ingredients for the lunches, those who made the sandwiches and prepared the bags and served them. The list is long. We had quite a number of parishioners who phoned in after the call for volunteers at the Masses on November 26, offering help; we had to turn down a number of offers, as the kitchen at First Baptist has space for a limited number of workers.

Both events were evidence that we have a true and caring community in our parish. Our parish truly "rocks"....

We are pleased to announce that Shannon Novak has agreed to sit on the Parish Council, to work on areas that have to do with the spiritual life of the parish. The Council welcomes her generosity and her experience in that fundamental aspect of our community.

One of the biggest and most joyful events for our parish this year will be the Transitional Diaconate Ordination of Daniel Malone on December 18, officiated by Archbishop Don. It has been a long time (longer than some of us can remember!) since someone from our parish has been ordained in this church. Daniel was baptized, confirmed, and served as altar boy at Holy Rosary Cathedral; his family have been members of this parish for decades. And now he will receive one of the three major Holy Orders, that of Deacon, here as well. Though our pride in him can never come close to that of his parents, we like to think of him as "our Daniel", and are overjoyed that he will receive that sacrament in the church where he grew in his faith.

We offer our prayers and very best wishes for Daniel, and look forward to next spring when he is to be ordained Priest.

Despite a couple of snags, the first phase of renovations is finally proceeding as planned. Because of the cathedral's decades-old infrastructure, these snags are not surprising and some delays have to be expected. Having announced this a few times, this time FOR SURE, the washrooms in the vestibule of the church are no longer accessible for the time being.

Those in the basement and the sacristy are available. And again, we thank you for your patience at the disruptions we all have to endure. The leadership team on this project is doing its best to ensure the smooth running of events and liturgies in the church.

You will notice that the bricks have been removed from the rear structure of the cathedral, to allow for the work on the deterioration in that area. Those particular bricks cannot be duplicated today and are being preserved to be put back once the repairs are done.

Meanwhile our Building and Grounds Committee have been busy with immediate, necessary maintenance and repairs in the cathedral's building and premises. Much of that work this past year was not expected, and thus not anticipated in the budget. (We homeowners know that reality only too well!) The bad news is that at the moment **the parish is facing a deficit of @ \$45,000 in 2023**, brought on for the most part by these unexpected and expensive repairs in the hall and in the grounds (including new parking-lot lights, which alone cost over \$11,000). The increase in the cost of electricity and gas and the rise in the cost of insurance on the building have not helped.

There are not enough words to thank the members of the B&G committee. They are all volunteers, and wherever they can, have done and continue to do much of the needed work themselves. Their generosity, the time they give in keeping our building safe and comfortable is a tremendous benefit to the parish. They respond to emergencies any time Fr. Dan or the office calls on them.

That spirit in our parishioners is what has kept our community vibrant for over a century.

As of the **end of October**: our **actual revenue** (from offertory collections, donations, and hall rentals) **was \$317,555, the prorated budget \$354,292**. Our expenses were at \$371,654, the **prorated budget \$363,093**.

Our hope is that the spirit of Christmas will help boost our revenue before the end of the year.

If you think this is a plea for your consideration, you are not wrong. We are all facing challenges in this economically turbulent time, and understand the limitations of your continuing generosity. Adding stress on you is the last thing we want, but if there is a chance that you can help to keep our parish solvent, we will be most grateful. Any increase in your donations, however small or big, will be welcome. As the old adage says, "The ocean is made up of many drops of water." Corny, but true.

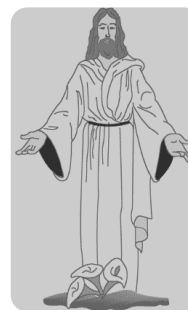

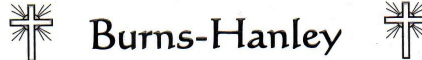

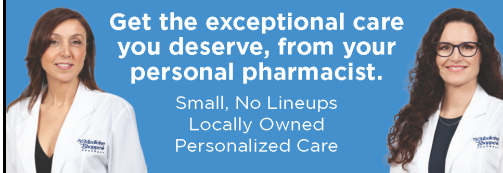
