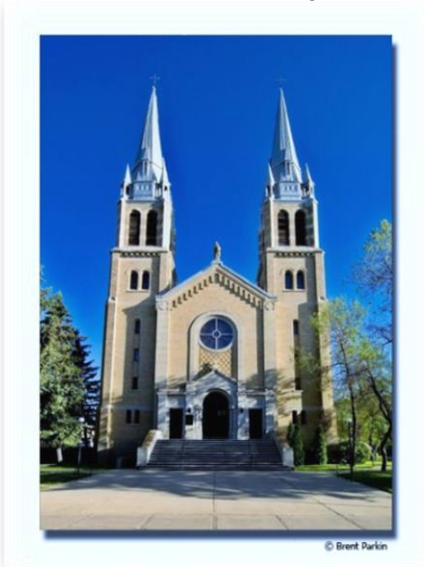

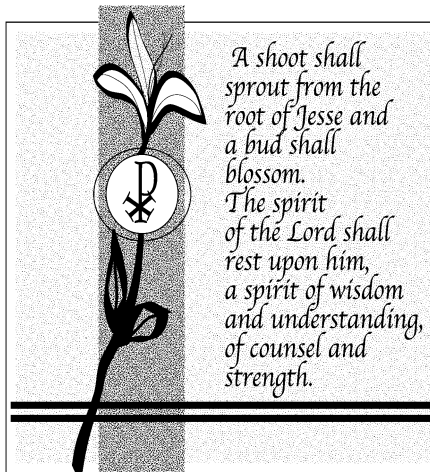

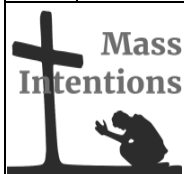

Dear fellow parishioners,

We have reached the last month of the year, so we are simplifying our presentation of what is still needed to meet our parish's collection budget for 2019.

Our December collection budget this year is \$55,000, which would match what was collected in December of 2018. If we reach that amount, that would mean we will meet our 2019 expenses but will be short \$70,000 we planned to use for needed repairs in 2020.

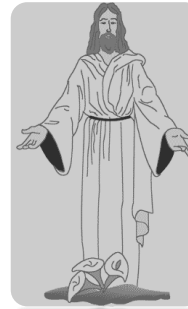

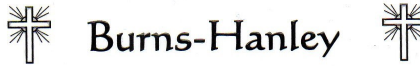
