

Dear fellow parishioners and visitors,

The first month of 2023 is over. Time flies indeed, but there is almost all of the new year ahead to give us time to fulfill our resolutions and to give us hope: hope that the wars and calamities around the world will come to an end, that the pandemic can become history. We hope, and we pray.

And we have some reason as a community of faith to hope for better days to come. The past year saw an increase in attendance at Sunday Masses; the 7:00 p.m. Mass on Christmas day saw over 500 in the pews! Quite remarkable, still though not up to pre-pandemic days. We had quite a number of weddings and baptisms in 2022, and our sacramental preparations saw a goodly number of children at First Reconciliation and First Communion. Our community came together for a successful *Oktoberfest* (after a 2-year hiatus), and at the fund-raising Rummage Sales in June and November.

Speaking of which, our indefatigable Bernadette Kutarna has rallied volunteers once again for another fund-raiser: a pre-Valentine Roast Beef Dinner in our auditorium on Friday, February 10. Her goal is to finally make the \$30K needed to reunite a refugee family in Syria with the rest of their family who had come to Regina earlier. The fund is short @ \$3000. Over the last 3 years, she organized the Rummage Sales, yard-cleaning, RR games parking on our lot, and collection of recyclables, among other events. She has shown us what Social Justice means, in action.

Tickets for the dinner (\$25) can be purchased in our vestibule after Masses on February 5, at Burns-Hanley, The Umbrella Shop, the parish office, or from Bernadette.

Though Christmas celebrations and experiences are probably still on many minds, we begin to look to Easter and Lent, which begins on **February 22**, **Ash Wednesday**. There will be two Masses that day: 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. **Stations of the Cross** devotion will be on Fridays at 6:00 p.m. starting February 24. **Fr. Scott** will be giving **Lenten Reflections** at the Saturday Masses (9:00 a.m.) on **March 4**, **11**, **18**, **and 25**.

Other events in our cathedral in February: Regina Symphony concerts on February 4 and 25, at 2:00 and 7:30 p.m. both days. The first concert features the orchestra playing Stravinsky and Shostakovich, the second has the Chamber group playing Baroque music (Telemann, Corelli, Bach).

And finally, good news on the financial front: thanks to your continuing generosity, the 2022 financial statement shows we have a surplus of @\$20K, which we badly need to decrease some of our liability to the archdiocese. You will also notice that work has begun on the Workplace Accessibility project in the Sacristy. We received an \$81K grant from the Federal Gov't. to which we are adding \$160K from our Building Fund. There will be stair lifts leading to the Sacristy and to the lower part of the Sanctuary, and a renovated washroom in the Sacristy. The work, which will take 6-8 weeks, will allow the laity and clergy with mobility issues to participate more fully in the liturgy.

May God bless us all.



#### A Word About Trauma...

Trauma and associated words are being used more now than ever. Do we know the origins of these words? Are their meanings different now than when they were first used? Each week we will explore a trauma-associated word's origins, meanings and evolution.

Trauma is the Greek word for "wound" and was first recorded in 1685 in the medical literature and only described physical wounds. Two centuries later, "Psychic wounds" would be used and began the shift of what we see trauma as now. CAMH describes trauma as "the lasting emotional response that often results from living through a distressing event." Although trauma can still be used to explain physical wounds, it is now more associated with emotional or psychological trauma.

Did you know...Cowessess First Nation is located along the Crooked Lake Valley 15 kilometers north of Broadview. The population is approximately 4300 members who reside on and off the First Nation. Chief Ka-wezauce (Little Boy) adhered to Treaty 4 on September 15, 1874, with his Anishinabe (Saulteaux), Nêhiweyak (Cree), & Metis followers. The Marieval Indian Residential School was in the valley and operated by the RC church from 1899 to 1997. Today, Cowessess Community Educational Centre, a K - Grade 12 school with 196 students stands in this location and is operated by the First Nation.
