



# SOCIAL JUSTICE AT HOLY ROSARY CATHEDRAL: "Turn Debt into Hope"

More than 3.3 billion people live in countries that are spending more on debt payments than on health or education. Some of this debt is due to costs incurred by wealthy nations that, in the past, claimed these now independent countries as their colonies. The debt continues when wealthy countries, including Canada, take the natural resources from these countries without paying attention to basic human rights such as clean water, fair payment of wages, basic acknowledgement that all people are created by God equally and equally are entitled to clean water, clean air, education, decent housing, good health, etc.

Development and Peace/Caritas Canada, along with churches in Canada are working toward reversing this tragedy. Please take home the pamphlet found in the pews, read it, and come to the front doors of the church to sign a petition begging the political and financial leaders of the world to 1. stop the debt crisis, 2. address the real underlying reasons for the debt, and 3. work with the United Nations to create a debt framework to handle debt.

When any of us in our parish fall into debt, that means we can't do many things, and may go without basic needs. This is happening to a number of countries around the world.






