



Ash Wednesday, on Feb 26 marks the beginning of the Season of Lent. It is a season of penance, reflection, and fasting which prepares us for Christ's Resurrection on Easter



Sunday, through which we attain redemption. The ashes are made from the blessed palms used in the Palm Sunday celebration of the previous year. The ashes are christened with Holy Water and are scented by exposure to incense. While the ashes symbolize penance and contrition, they are also a reminder that God is gracious and merciful to those who call on Him with repentant hearts.

GIVE IT UP FOR LENT If you are thinking of doing something meaningful for Lent, ANCOP Regina and the Couples for Christ would like to invite you to their "Give It Up for Lent" challenge. 
