### **"A Kindness a Day during Lent"**

The above calendar serves as a simple reminder of how you may wish to enrich your Lenten journey through the undertaking of simple Acts of Kindness. By doing Little Acts of Kindness, you are sharing the love you have to give with family, friends and everyone you meet. Check off circle a 'footprint' for each Act of Kindness for each day on your Lenten walk with the Lord. There are many things you can do as little expressions of kindness, such as the following:

- Visit or call someone who is sick or elderly and bring them a simple meal, soup, or loaf of homemade bread;
- Give someone a smile who needs it — spend some time with them to help cheer them up;
- Yield the right-of-way to another driver or give up a parking space — give them a wave and a smile rather than a frown;
- Bring someone a coffee who would appreciate it;
- Help out at home where needed;
- Contribute or help at a soup kitchen or similar facility;
- Help shovel someone's driveway or walkway;
- Help an elderly person get their groceries or offer them a drive in the cold/slippery weather;
- Baby-sit for a young couple or single mother so that they can enjoy an evening out;
- Run an errand for someone who needs it;
- Spend some time listening to someone because many times people are too busy to do so;
- Open a door for someone;
- Opportunities for kindness present themselves during every hour of every day — take advantage of them as often and wherever you can! Use your imagination. And don't forget to enjoy the journey! You'll be in the best of Company.

## HOLY ROSARY CATHEDRAL FINANCIAL STEWARDSHIP

On behalf of your Parish Finance Committee, we thank you for your contributions to the Parish this past year. However, we are sure that you have noticed in the Sunday bulletins, that the weekly contributions have been less than the weekly budgeted amount required to operate this Parish. For the fiscal year 2016, presently we have a **DEFICIT OF \$33,000** (there will be some adjustments to this amount).

The **2017 budget** to operate this Parish is **\$439,000**. As you know, costs here continue to rise the same as it does in your household. The size, age and the need to preserve the heritage aspects of Holy Rosary Cathedral, a landmark in our community, all add to our costs. Our utility cost this past year was \$32,000 and our insurance cost was \$35,000. As with most parishes, salaries is the big expense and that total was \$150,000.

Our Parish exists to provide a spiritual home for all of our parishioners. To do this, we must be financially viable, that is, able to maintain our building and able to offer the services that make Holy Rosary an attractive parish and spiritual home. The Parish depends on your contributions to cover almost 90% of the expenses. We ask all parishioners to help support the Parish, through the regular use of envelopes or, if you wish, sign up for **AUTOMATIC FUND TRANSFER** (forms are on the tables at the entrances of the Church).

Are you contributing fairly and in accordance with the importance of Holy Rosary Cathedral to your family's well-being? Has your donation changed in recent years to consider your changed circumstances or changing needs of the Parish. We encourage you to take this opportunity to prayerfully consider the financial needs of your spiritual home.
