





#### **Optional Indoor Masking in Saskatchewan**

As of February 28, 2022 indoor masking is optional in the province of Saskatchewan. Eucharist should continue to be distributed in the form of the Body of Christ only at this time and not include the common cup.

Anyone who is sick should stay home. Although the public dispensation from Mass has not been in effect since August 2021 (see <u>Lifting the Dispensation on Sunday Mass Attendance</u>), the sick and medically vulnerable have always been dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. If you are ill, elderly, or medically vulnerable in any way, you are urged to continue to take every precaution to keep yourself and others safe.

Over the last five years the Archdiocese of Regina has embarked on a progressive dialogue with victims of clergy sexual abuse in an on-going effort to change the way those who were abused were treated. In this workshop the Archdiocesan Core Working Group members will share and discuss the best practices that have led to practical and tangible ways to provide a victim-centred approach that helps people impacted by the legacy of clergy sexual abuse and works to educate non-victims. Topics addressed include a victim sharing how abuse impacted her life, transparency, and accountability from a victim's perspective, accompanying and reaching out to victims, and educational and parish resources, all aimed at reducing re-victimization and initiating a change of culture around the exercise of authority.

Did you know that... in the latter 19th and early 20th centuries it was commonly thought that diseases like tuberculosis, measles, whooping cough, and influenza were hereditary among First Nation people. All these diseases were brought here by the newcomers. Rates that were as much as twenty times that of neighbouring settler communities Whereas, in actual fact, the causes were driven by malnourishment and overcrowded living conditions in housing on the reserves and in residential schools.
