



Dear parishioners and visitors,

Happy new year to you and your dear ones! Or perhaps we should say, "Happier" new year! Indeed, we are all hoping that the anxieties and isolation of 2020 can be put behind us soon.

Looking back over the past ten months, we reflect gratefully on what helped us (and continues to help us) cope with the uncertainties and abnormalcy of our current world. Among the many blessings would be our faith and the community that sustains that faith. Our parish has managed to keep standing, thanks to so many: our Office Manager Ana, our Accountant John, and the members of the Pastoral and Financial Councils who have kept the wheels moving; Tanya and her cantors and the 7:00 p.m. choir, who enhance our liturgies with their inspiring music; the volunteers who relieve Ana of some of her work in the office, especially Carol, who has been handling registration for the Masses; the Knights of Columbus and members of the Building Committee who volunteer hours taking care of our beautiful church; the lectors and ushers and greeters who serve at the Masses, and Brad and Joanne who organize their schedules. Without them, our Pastor would be hard-pressed to keep our parish safe and spiritually alive.

We continue to deal with the pandemic situation as best we can. There has been no change in limits to gathering in the church. However, another Mass has been - on Saturday evenings at 6:00 p.m., starting February 6 - to allow 30 more people to have a chance at attending the liturgy. Please register either by e-mail (cschimnosky@sasktel.net) or by phone (306-565-0909) between 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m., Mondays - Thursdays.

The Pastoral Council is planning our Annual General Meeting for Sunday, March 21. At the moment, it is uncertain whether or not we can meet in person by then, or if we must find some other means to present to you our reports for the year 2020.

The planned resumption in our cathedral at the end of March of the Regina Symphony Orchestra concert series is still uncertain, obviously. However, the enthusiastic response of patrons to the concerts last October and November has prompted the RSO to ask if they can plan to perform in the cathedral post-pandemic. They are designing a Baroque series and a smaller - orchestral Masterworks repertoire that would be suitable for the space in our church. The hope is that some kind of normalcy will have been restored by September and they can return to the Conexus Centre for the larger Masterworks and POPS series. They have a new exciting vision for the orchestra that will include Holy Rosary Cathedral from 2021-22 and onwards. If all goes well, they will be performing in our church for ten weeks from September to April.

That is the plan, God willing.

A full financial statement will be made available to you prior to the AGM in March, including the 2021 budget. You will be happy to know that although we did not meet our anticipated \$75K Building Fund budget, we **are closing our 2020 financial books without a deficit**. The gov't. wage subsidy was a big help, as was the fact that our expenses were understandably lower because of the pandemic. As well, the RSO fees made up to some extent for the diminished revenue from church and auditorium rentals. **More than all that, thank you for your extra donations in December. Your generosity and loyalty are a tremendous blessing.** In addition to your donations to the church, **you have donated \$49,505 to the annual Archbishop's Appeal, which comes to 81.61% of our \$60,658 goal.** That is truly outstanding, in a year of financial struggles for so many.


2020 could have been worse after all!

TF230: Inoculating Truth: The Morality of Vaccination - Part 1

As vaccines begin to roll out promising protection from COVID-19 and a slow return to normal life, there remain some questions regarding the morality of some vaccines which may have connections

with ethically questionable cell-lines. Deacon Eric and Dr. Brett navigate the waters in this two-part look at the morality of vaccination. Warning: These episodes may cause irritation and inflammation at the injection site, and a closer alignment with the consistent moral teachings of the Pope and teaching office of the Church.


