
There will be confessions on Saturday, March 25, following the 9:00 am Mass.

Did you know... Kawacatoose First Nation is a Cree nation located near Raymore and has a population of approximately 3, 200. Chief Kawacatoose signed Treaty 4 on September 15, 1874, and two years later received a reserve in the Big Touchwood Hills. The reserve was originally referred to as Poor Man reserve which was incorrectly named as Kawacatoose correctly translated means Lean Man or Skinny Man.
