





# Warm Welcome Coalition

# Support Needed for Warm Welcome Centre

Local faith communities, organizations and concerned citizens have come together, recognizing the crisis for the houseless community and the severe cold weather coming. This Warm Welcome Coalition has looked at multiple funding sources and are currently trying to secure funding, (i.e. grants and partnerships) for an overnight warming centre in Regina. Carmichael Outreach has offered their space and has developed a budget for staffing and managing this project. The centre will open from 11pm to 7am, 7 days a week from January to May, 2024. We expect to provide space for up to 60 people at the start. We see this as addressing an immediate need while we continue to press the governments for a more permanent solution to houselessness, i.e. affordable housing with wraparound supports (Housing First).


We are looking for volunteers to support the staff overnight and various donors (faith communities, individuals) to offer support by providing food and beverages.

Volunteers would need to apply through Carmichael's volunteer process including a police records check (\$10 fee). Volunteers will also be expected to go through an orientation (or experienced) to be prepared to deal with potential issues of working with this vulnerable population (e.g. Narcan/Naloxone administration; Cultural Humility – Newo-Yotina Centre)

Donors will be primarily drawn from faith communities. If we can get 30-31 regular donors, there would only be one night a month of donations needed. Donations could include items such as: Coffee/tea & supplies, juice; snacks, e.g. muffins, sandwiches, baking, fruit, etc and enough for 60 people. Some in the community are identifying the benefit of a hot meal. We could coordinate full meals for any who may wish to contribute them. There will be a time in the evening that items could be dropped off.


