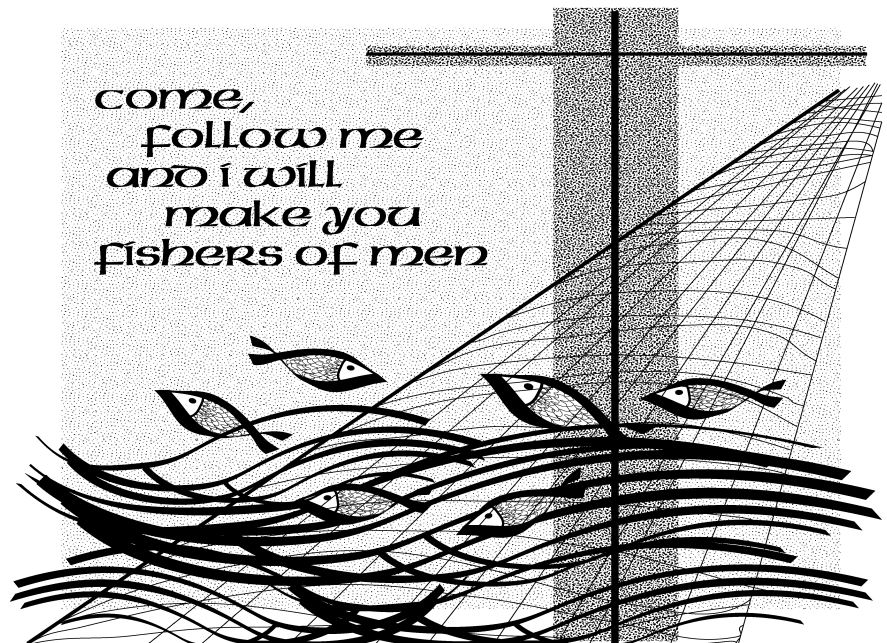

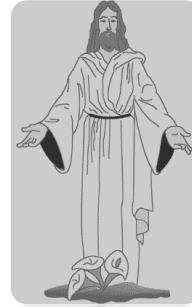

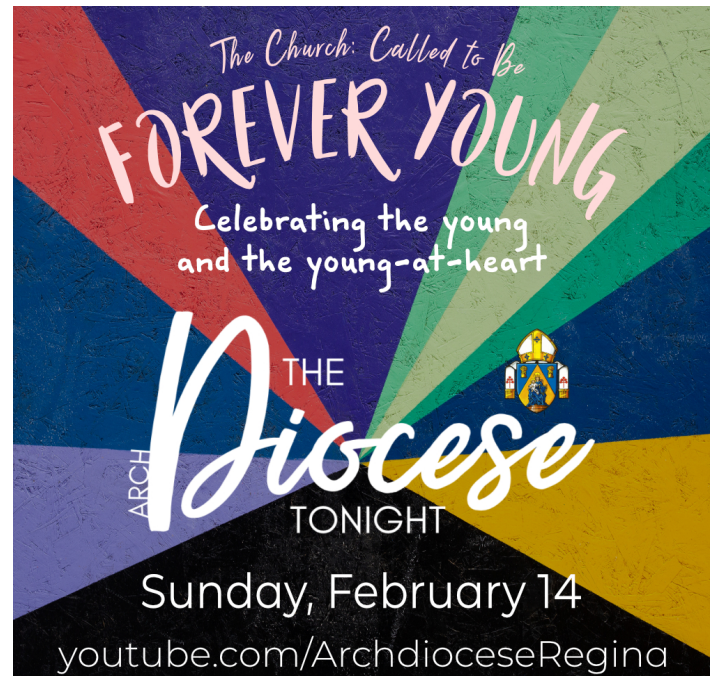
The Western Canadian Association of Catholic Youth Ministers Annual Gathering
