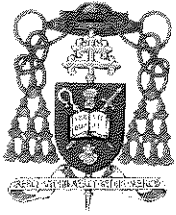

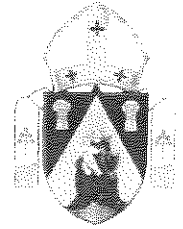

Holy Rosary Cathedral respectfully acknowledges that we are situated on Treaty 4 territory, traditional lands of First Nations and Métis people.

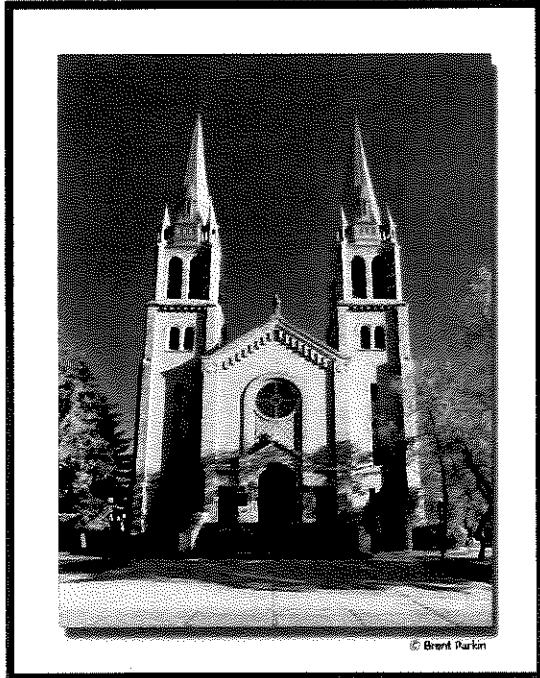

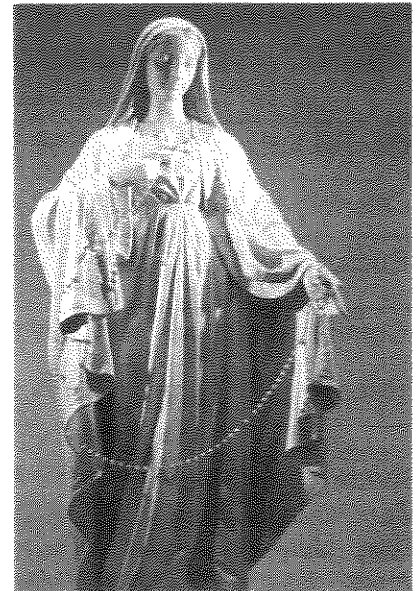

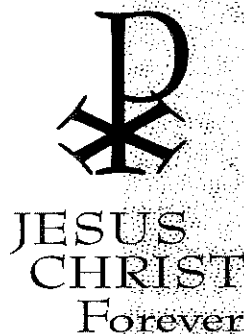
