





BISHOP'S DELEGATE ON CLERGY SEXUAL ABUSE

After 4 years of service as the Bishop's delegate on Clergy Sexual Abuse, Fr. Bradford Fahlman is moving on to work in other areas in the Archdiocese. We are deeply grateful for his time and commitment as delegate. Archbishop Bolen has appointed Maureen Dumonceaux to succeed Fr. Brad. Archbishop Bolen has also appointed Deacon David Hudy as deputy delegate. Both appointments will start on August 1.

Both the confidential email enquiry@archregina.sk.... and the confidential phone number 1-306-400-3655 will continue to be utilized. It will be a continued practice that if the delegate is not available, the deputy delegate will be the contact person. At this time there are no policy changes.

We also would like to remind people that Lorie Harrison, RPC, MPCC is contracted to work with victims of clergy sexual abuse. Victims can self-refer or be referred by others. She can be contacted through a confidential email <u>lorie@heart-song.ca</u> or through her confidential phone number at 1-639-317-8104. counselling. You or someone you know may benefit from watching it. If you have any questions regarding counseling do not hesitate to contact Lorie.

The Victim Services and Advocacy person, Pamela Walsh, continues to be an available contact in this area as well. The mandate of the VSA is to provide outreach, accountability, and transparency for victims/survivors. She is also available to help others either with education or to provide education for non-victims, parishes, and others in the community about the accompaniment of victims, the legacy of clergy sexual abuse, prevention of abuse, and other related topics. 
