





Dear parishioners and visitors,

We cannot safely say that summer is finally here, but there are lovely colours in flower-beds, lush greens on the trees, activities in the parks.........

June was a busy month at the cathedral: a full house on June 1 for the Regina Symphony Orchestra's "Brahms Requiem" concert, the ordination into the priesthood of Daniel Malone on the 7th, and the ordination into the Permanent Diaconate of Martin Kondzielewski and Ken Fahlman on the 14th. The first event saw a large number of RSO patrons who had never been to the cathedral, and they were full of admiration not only for the concert but also for our church. Fr. Malone's ordination ceremony was a most touching event, enhanced by beautiful music from our choir, which was enlarged by his friends. And undoubtedly, the new Deacons are a welcome addition to the diocesan educational and liturgical services.

It was not a surprise that the renovations in the building were not completed at the end of the month, as we know too well the pressures on construction companies. We have been assured that the end is near, and the results will be to our satisfaction. We hope to have a celebration sometime at the end of summer to mark the completion of the first phase of badly needed work on the building. This project is not just for the benefit of our parish but of the whole archdiocese; the maintenance and preservation of this century-year-old building is both a historical necessity and a religious one. It is not only a lovely structure but part of the city's heritage and the mother-church of our community of faith. What we put into its preservation today will ensure its continuing use in the next hundred years.

Evanne, our Director of Music, is taking a sabbatical leave from the beginning of August this year until the end of June 2025. She hopes to complete her studies towards an M.A. in Music from the University of Saskatoon. Filling the position is Jessica Stroeder, who completed her organ scholarship last month. She has been part of the cathedral's organist rota for the past two years and has substituted for Evanne in conducting the choir a few times. She has completed a Bachelor of Music course of studies, had choral conducting classes, and has a semester of practice-teaching left toward a Bachelor of Education degree.

Our parish is truly blessed by the musicians who enhance our liturgies and special ceremonies and who work on preserving the tradition of centuries-old church music alongside keeping up with the new.

And it cannot be said enough: another blessing is the strong spirit of volunteering in our parish! On May 25, several volunteers turned out for the Downtown Saturday lunch, which we hosted at First Baptist Church. The call for donations, monetary as well as necessary items, elicited extraordinary generosity from parishioners. Thanks to Bernadette for always keeping us mindful of the needs of others and for making the meaning of social justice concrete.




