New Member of Jesuit Community in Regina:


Rev. John David O'Brien Will be joining the Jesuit Community here in Regina and teaching at



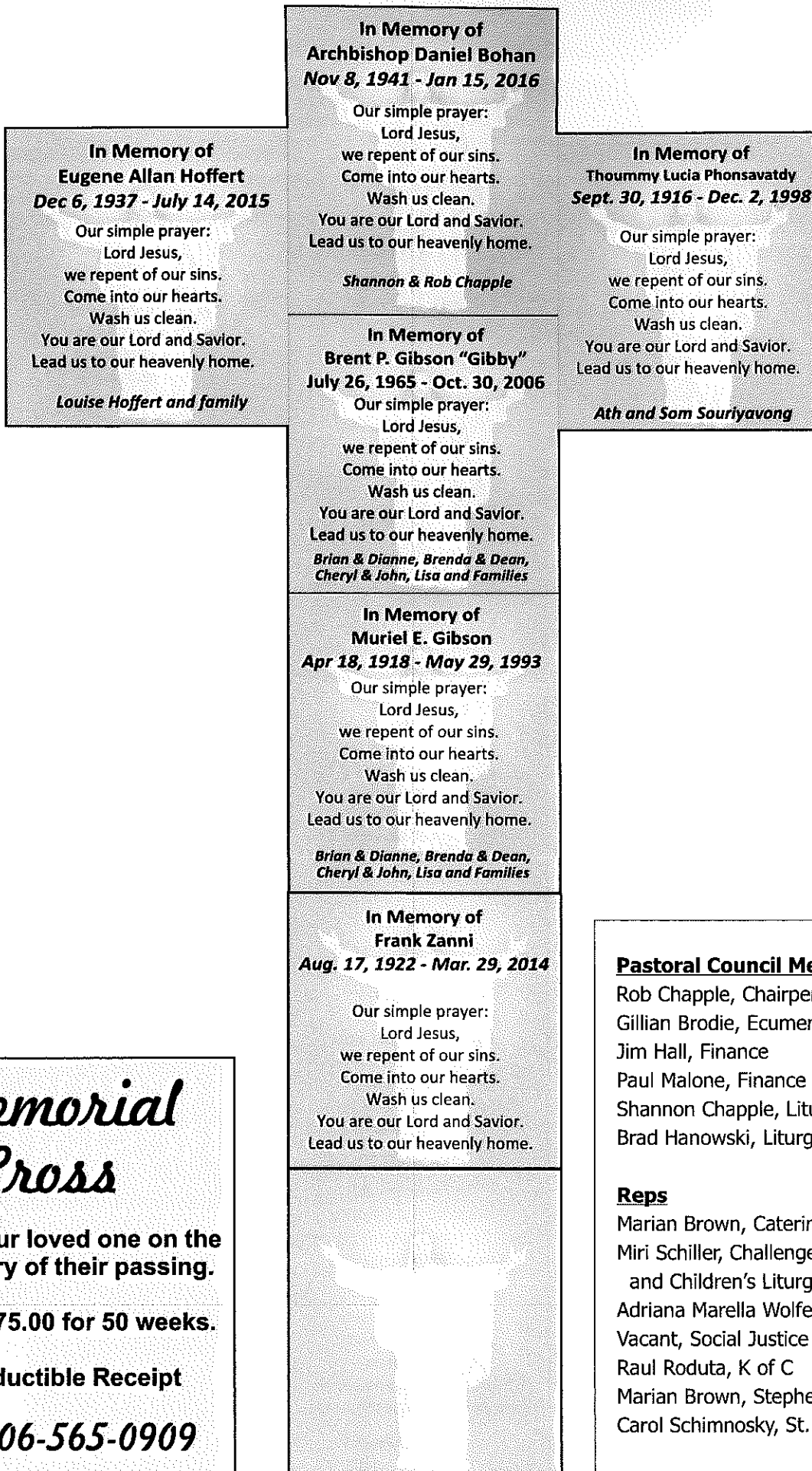

Holy Rosary Cathedral Parking Lot (East Side)

The Parish Council and the Finance Committee have recently been considering options for improving the parking situation in the east side lot of the Cathedral.

Over the past year it has become apparent that at certain times during the week the parking lot is heavily used when there are not any events at the Cathedral. Conversely, there are times when Cathedral parishioners attending masses or other Cathedral events have not been able to park in the Cathedral lot because non-parishioners have filled most of the spots.

The Cathedral parking lot is used by non-parishioners because:

- It's convenient to 13th Ave. businesses; people attending services and events at Westminster United Church; and Catholic School Division employees;
- Access to the parking lot is available 24 hours a day; and
- There's no charge for parking.

The cost of maintaining the parking lot is borne solely by Cathedral parishioners. Over the past 5 years the maintenance costs have exceeded \$81,000:

- Cost of resurfacing – August 2009 – \$70,327
- Signage - 2009 – \$1103
- Painting lines – 2009 - \$1155
- Painting lines – 2012 - \$3150
- Snow removal – 2012 - \$1192
 - 2013 - \$577
 - 2014 - \$1481
 - 2015 - \$830
 - 2016 - \$1742

Annual maintenance is required for the parking lot to tar cracks caused by freeze/thaw cycles and to repaint the lines. This annual maintenance has not been done since at least 2012 because of financial constraints.

Of the options considered by the Parish Council and the Finance Committee for dealing with the issues of availability of parking for parishioners and financing the annual maintenance costs, the most viable one in the view of the Council is to implement a parking fee for non-parishioners to use the east side parking lot.

To implement this parking fee system would require contracting with a parking company like Impark or Precise ParkLink to:

- Install a payment machine to dispense tickets to display on vehicle dashboards;
- Install signage indicating the parking fees, etc.; and
- Patrol the parking lot as required and issue tickets to vehicles which haven't paid the required fee.

Parishioners would not be charged for parking.

Each parishioner who uses the parking lot to attend mass or other Cathedral functions would be issued an annual tag to hang from the vehicle's rear view mirror. Visitors coming for mass would be issued a temporary tag upon request.

The intent of initiating a parking charge for non-parishioners is to hopefully generate enough annual income to cover the parking lot maintenance costs and to also ensure parking is available for parishioners attending mass and other events at the Cathedral.

Before embarking on this initiative, we request your comments. Are you in favour of paid parking for non-parishioners using the east side parking lot?

If not, why not?

If opposed, do you have suggestions for alternatives to paid parking for non-parishioners to address the issues of sufficient parking for parishioners and to generate income for the annual maintenance costs for the east side lot?
