

Dear parishioners & friends,

The good news is that starting June 8th, the provincial health advisory is allowing gatherings of **30 participants** at church services. For weekdays, Tuesday-Saturday, there will be an adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 8 a.m. followed by Mass at 9 a.m. Furthermore, Fr. Dan is having a Saturday Mass at 6 p.m. starting tomorrow, June 6th, and an additional Mass on Sunday at 4 p.m. starting June 14th. The same protocol for attendance remains: you must call Ana (306-565-0909) at the parish office to get your names on the lists. And the same protocols will hold in the church: 6-ft. social distancing and sanitizing of pews.

We are most grateful to those who continue to support the parish financially. The donations from parishioners in May, slightly better than in April, totalled \$ 29,634 (only \$3000 less than what was donated in May 2019). We consider ourselves blessed in the generosity of our parishioners in this time of financial difficulty. Though we have not been gathering for Mass, donations have continued to come in through envelopes dropped off in baskets in the church, via mail, e-transfer, and automatic bank transfer.

It is, however, still worrisome that in the **last five months, total revenue has amounted to \$72,720 less** than our prorated budget (\$157, 550 vs. \$230,270). Aside from a decline in collections, a good part of the shortfall is due to lack of other revenue (e.g. hall rentals, weddings, vigil lights). On the brighter side, however, our expenses to date are a bit less than anticipated, because of diminished activities in the last three months.

That does not mean that there has been no activity. The Building and Grounds Committee have been busy with repairs and maintenance, and thanks to volunteers generous with their time and expertise, at no cost to the parish. At the risk of excluding the many who have contributed to the maintenance of our church, we would like to thank Jim Nichols, Ray Plosker, Rob Chapple, Mark Scott, Greg Loziak, Paul Adekogbe and Brian Harris who worked to improve the drainage on the east side of the cathedral. Jim, Ray, and Brian, in particular, have also been repairing and installing new windows in the towers, not an easy task to say the least. Our deepest gratitude as well goes to the parishioner who donated materials and his labour in repairing parts of the ceiling around the altar and arches where there was water damage; he wants to remain anonymous.

In the next few months, there will be repairs done to the flat part of the roof over the sacristy, to the west towers, and to the stairs leading to the sacristy.

The dedication and generosity of so many in our parish illustrates the pride we all have in our place of worship and in our community.


