



You can save a dollar by skipping your favorite coffee, drink, dessert, skip eating out for meals, or anything you can sacrifice for a day for forty days.


You can put the dollar in the Lenten offering envelope for each day. This is also a great Lenten activity that you can do with your children or grandchildren.


