Did you know... The Nehiyawak (Cree) had many spiritual ceremonies including the sundance, rainedance, sweat-lodge, pipe ceremonies, vision quests, feasts, giveaways, and many more since time immemorial. The Indian Act of 1876 banned these ceremonies until 1951, however, these traditions survived, and many Nehiyawak participate in these spiritual traditions today.

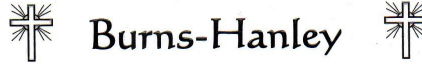
