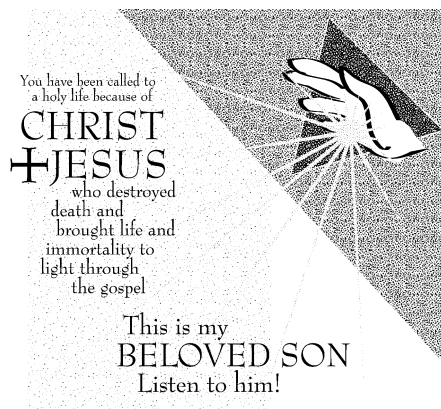

The Way of the Cross Through the Voice of Victims – Supporting Victims of Clergy Sexual Abuse on March 13 at 7 PM. For Christian believers, the stations of the cross are a traditional way of praying which draws us into the pain and suffering of Jesus, precisely in order to reveal the depth of God's love. But for victims of clergy sexual abuse, a church can be a very painful place. Where love was to be spoken and hope proclaimed, power was misused, wounds were inflicted and God's love was not revealed but hidden. You are invited to enter into this service, finding the courage to listen deeply and compassionately to those who were wounded where they should have found love. And to look for the presence of the wounded Jesus, walking in solidarity with the victims, and calling us all to conversion and compassion.

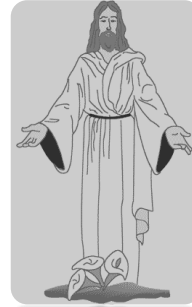
