



Our focus is on repairing failing infrastructure including heating, ventilation, and electrical systems, while transforming the hall into a more welcoming, accessible space for parish, archdiocesan and community gatherings.

This year, under the theme Pilgrims of Hope, Pope Francis invites Catholics to renew their hope and adopt a vision that can "restore access to the fruits of the earth to everyone." Let us take up our walking sticks and walk with our sisters and brothers.


