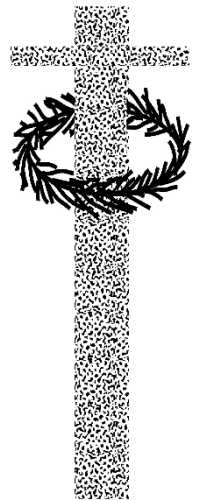

WEEK 1 OF CATHEDRAL RENEWAL: OUR CATHEDRAL, OUR STORY

This week marks the launch of Phase 3 of the **Rebuilding Our Church Capital Campaign**. Just as a house needs attention over the years, our cathedral home requires essential repairs to continue serving our community.

From now until mid-May, we will be sharing updates on this next chapter of restoration. Our focus is on repairing failing infrastructure including heating, ventilation, and electrical systems, while transforming the hall into a more welcoming, accessible space for parish, archdiocesan and community gatherings.

2025 COLLECTION UPDATE

Our **February** regular Mass collections total was: \$28,216.15 and building fund donations were \$3,757. Current totals to date for Mass collections is **\$61,481.75** and building fund donations is **\$9,137.30**. Inspired by Catholic Social Teaching, the bishops of Canada... join the global Catholic campaign, "Turn Debt into Hope"...In the name of all the bishops of Canada, I invite you to act alongside Development and Peace - Caritas Canada, the official international development organization of the Catholic Church in Canada."(excerpt from William T. McGrattan, President, Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops). More will be coming as we SHARE LENT, leading to SOLIDARITY SUNDAY. One important fact about Development and Peace (D&P) for today: D&P partners with communities in impoverished countries such as Tunisia, Sudan, Ethiopia, the Philippines, Peru, etc., rather than with providing sponsorship for only individuals. Communities know what is needed to feed, clothe, shelter and educate their people. D&P provides the resources to do just that, so that the entire community benefits together.

A walking stick that so many of us use on the ice these days, symbolizes the pilgrimage to which we are all invited in this Jubilee year. Celebrated every 25 years in the Catholic Church, a Jubilee is a special year of forgiveness and reconciliation, in which people are invited to come back into right relationships with God, with one another, and with all of Creation. The tradition is inspired by the biblical year of jubilee, a time when debts are cancelled, slaves are set free, and the land is allowed to rest (Lev. 25, Deut. 15). This year, under the theme Pilgrims of Hope, Pope Francis invites Catholics to renew their hope and adopt a vision that can "restore access to the fruits of the earth to everyone." Let us take up our walking sticks and walk with our sisters and brothers.

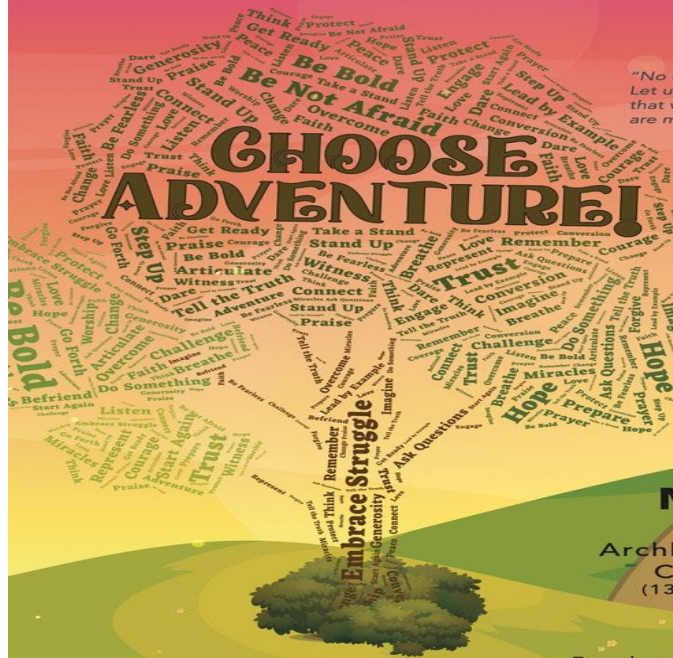

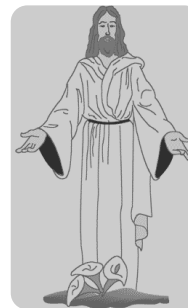

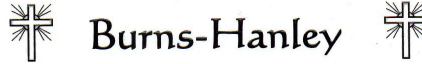
