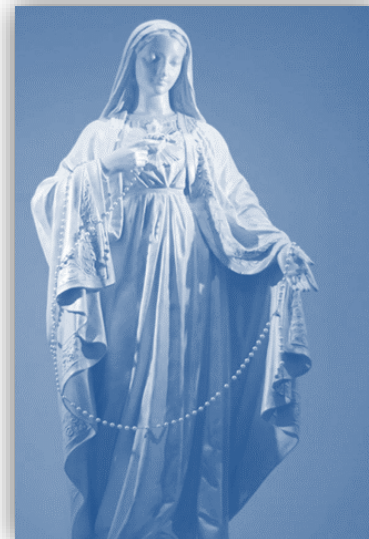



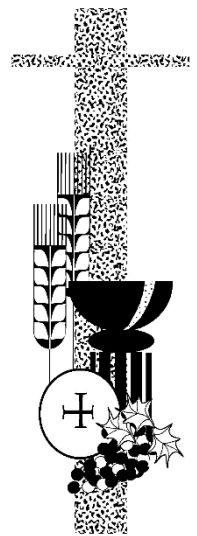

"This weighing scale demonstrates the unfairness of the situation in which countries of the Global South are burdened with disastrous external debt while their land resources are taken from

them. In Peru, peasant and Indigenous communities suffer the results of an "ecological debt" when foreign companies take the resources of their land, contaminate the soil, air and water, and violate their human rights while not doing anything for the local communities. Development and Peace/Caritas Canada's partners such as the Episcopal Commission for Social Action train and inform affected communities to understand, defend and assert their rights. Their mission is to further human development and the common good of local villages and towns, to make sure there is a 'preferential option for the poor'."

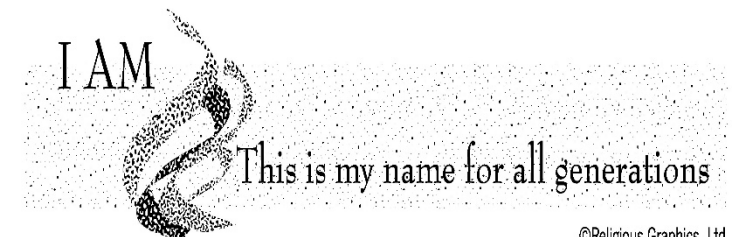
MENTAL HEALTH & FAITH: A CONVERSATION ON SUPPORT AND HOPE

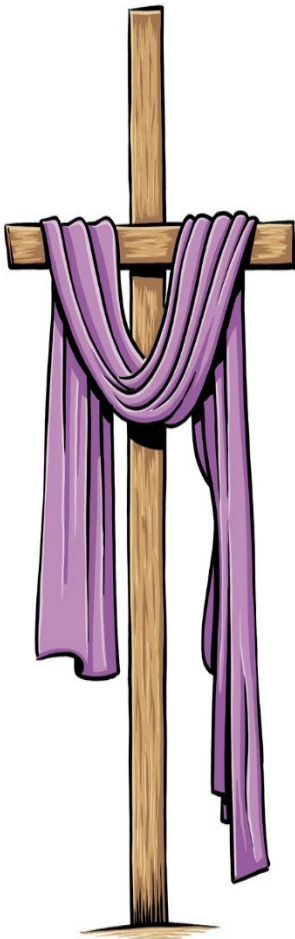

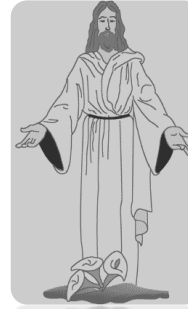

Peru is facing an ecological debt crisis as extractive industries, often foreign-owned, plunder its natural resources, harming the environment and human rights.

These industries contribute to the unjust enrichment of the Global North at the expense of the Global South. Thus, as countries in the Global South incur financial debts that further impoverish them, they are owed a mounting ecological debt by the Global North that is never settled.

Our partners, the Episcopal Commission for Social Action (CEAS) and the Institute Bartolomé de Las Casas (IBC) work closely with affected communities, advocating for justice and sustainable alternatives. 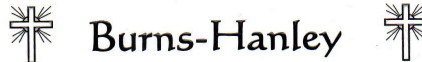
