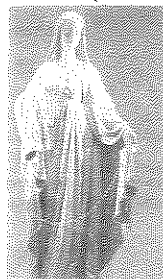
FLOWERS IN MEMORY OF LOVED ONES

On **Ash Wednesday**, we began our Lenten observance. You may have noticed when you entered the church today that there was no prelude music, and no decorations at the altar. During the season of Lent, in accordance with the General Instruction of the Roman Missal, we abstain from placing flowers at the altar. Musical instruments are used only to accompany the singing, and we don't sing the Gloria or "alleluia" until their triumphant return during the Triduum. This use of silence and sparseness helps us remember the penitential character of the season, and provides an external sign for our sorrow for sin and firm resolve to respond to the merciful love of God and not sin again.

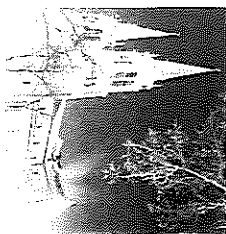
Sacred Heart Community School Art 4 Heart Gala

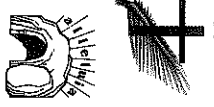
