





Please join us in a difficult task because of the pandemic – fundraising so that we can bring a young husband and wife and their little boy, 3, and little girl, 2, to Regina. The young woman has UNHCR refugee status. The little girl has a health issue. Her needs are not being met because she is part of a refugee family living in exile. This young family fled their home and are now staying in a neighbouring country, where life is very difficult. They do not belong in exile. If you would be willing to support us in raising the funds needed to sponsor them to Canada, we would be most appreciative. Her parents here tell us that they have experienced many kindnesses from Canadians and thank you very kindly in advance for your support.

Our first two efforts are as follows:

#### 1. **SARCAN Drop and Go**

If you wish to donate your recyclables to our effort, you can drop off your bag of bottles, cans, cartons, etc., at any depot in Saskatchewan. Go to the 'Drop and Go' kiosk, type in **Kind Welcome**, take the label and stick one on each bag. Cheques will be picked up and placed in the account opened for the purpose of this sponsorship. All proceeds will be toward the sponsorship of this family. PLEASE REMEMBER: TAKE OFF BOTTLE CAPS!

If you live in Regina and area, we are most willing to arrange for a monthly pick up. We will deliver your containers to SARCAN. To do this, call or text Bernadette on her mobile at (306) 537-4158. You can even arrange for a monthly reminder if you wish one, by text, email or phone.

#### 2. Odd Jobs

It is springtime and all of us have spring cleaning to do indoors and outdoors. With the volunteer help of our group of 10, we are initiating an 'Odd Job' drive. Here's how it works: Give us a call or text or email telling us of your request. We will get in touch with you to arrange date, time and place. Some jobs that we could do include:

- a. wash outside windows main floor only.
- b. cleaning eavestroughs bungalow only.
- c. some outside painting jobs.
- d. basic yard care, including raking, cutting lawn, pulling weeds, etc. No chemical work please.
- e. some limited housework, including washing floors, inside windows and walls.
- f. other odd jobs as negotiated. Just ask.

We are asking for a minimum \$15/ hour per person.

Time: weekends, late afternoon, after school/work during the week. During the day, on weekends and some holidays.

With indoor work, with my regrets, only non-smoking houses/ apartments. I have a medical allergy to cigarette smoke, and second-hand smoke. Masks will be worn by workers. Masks are requested by occupants when conversing with workers. Thanks!
