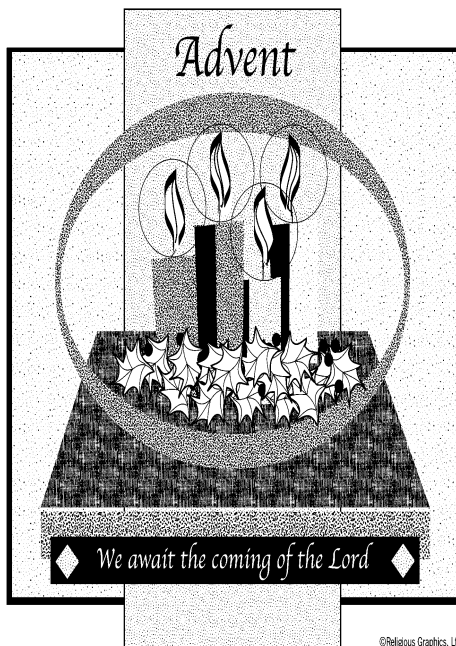

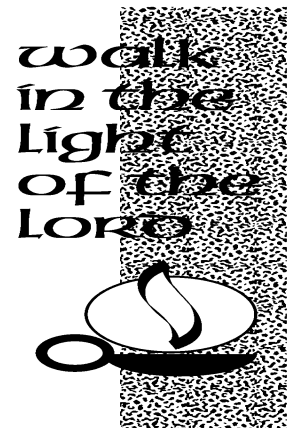

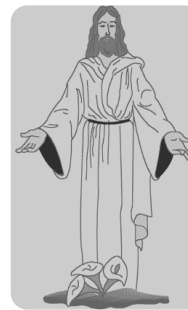

itwewin Corner (itwewin is the Cree word which means 'the word' or 'as it is said...')

Did you know... The term "Cree" is derived from the French renderings (Kristineaux, Kiristinous, Kilistinous) of the Ojibway term Kinistino. The proper term in the Plains Cree language is nêhiyawak. The Cree occupy a large area of Saskatchewan, from the northern woodlands areas to the southern plains. While being one people, there is a great variation amongst the different regional groups. One of the main differences is in terms of dialect, of which there are three main ones: "th" Woodlands, "y" Plains, and "n" Swampy Cree. LESSON SIX The Catechism: It's no secret!

No. The Catechism does not include a methodology. It is a complete and accurate explanation of Catholic doctrine. The Directory for Catechesis provides an over-all guide, but the procedure for transferring the faith depends on a variety of factors and it should be customized to reflect the circumstances and culture and local needs of those engaged in catechesis. Many diocese have created local guidelines for instruction.

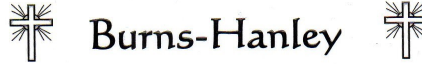
