



 $\ensuremath{\textit{Intolerance}}$  - negative portrayals in media or in social circles

**Discrimination** - treated differently from everyone else, particularly with respect to accessing employment or obtaining a permit to build a church or other religious building (while other religious groups have no such problems).

**Persecution** - singled out for arrest or detention, sent to work camps, tortured, and even killed.

**Genocide** - directed toward completely eradicating Christians from a region.




