itwewin Corner (itwewin is the Cree word which means 'the word' or 'as it is said...')

Fr. John Weckend, Archdiocese of Regina Truth and Reconciliation Healing Committee. Did you know... White Bear First Nation (whitebearfirstnation.ca) is located 13 kms North of Carlyle, Sask. in the scenic Moose Mountain area and consists of four First Nations (Cree, Saulteaux, Nakota, and Dakota). Chief Wahpemakwa signed an adhesion to Treaty 4 in 1875. The population is approximately 2900 members with 70% who live off reserve. The Bear Claw Casino opened in 1993 and was shut down because of a contentious battle with the provincial government regarding gaming in Saskatchewan. The federal government was also involved which led to a major change in the Indian Act of 1876. The Permit System was rescinded - a historic win for First Nations across Canada. Prior to 1996, First Nations had to get permission from the federal government to establish a business on their land. The Bear Claw Casino reopened in 1996.


