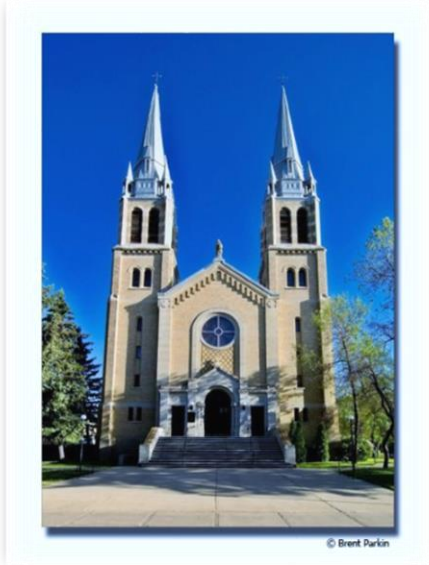

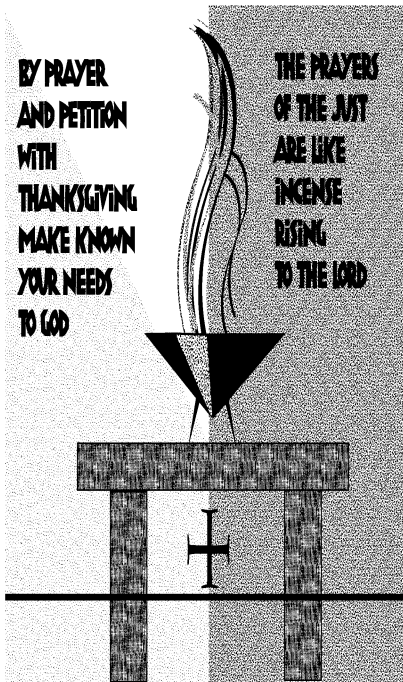

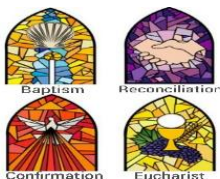
## BULLETIN REFLECTION

*1st Reading: Is 5.1-7 | 2nd Reading: Phil 4.6-9 | Gospel: Mt 21.33-43*

In today's readings, we hear the striking parallel between the prophet Isaiah and the parable of the landowner's vineyard. Isaiah tells us that it was the house of Israel that was to be the fertile soil for the welcoming of the Messiah, but out of hardness of heart, they did not accept him. Jesus explains that when the landowner leases his land to other tenants, it is to be understood as a sharing in the kingdom of God, since God gives us everything.

So, it is our mission to be thankful for the gifts that God has given us and to be generous with others so as to produce good fruit. This weekend is Thanksgiving, a special time to contemplate how to show our gratefulness. The bountiful produce of the earth is a visible sign of the many blessings God wants to shower on us through Christ. Our God also us to share the goods of the earth with all people. 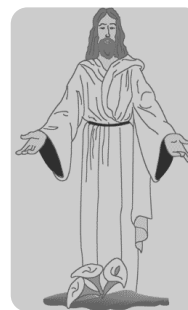

**itwewin Corner** (itwewin is the Cree word which means 'the word' or 'as it is said...') Fr. John Weckend, Archdiocese of Regina Truth and Reconciliation Healing Committee. Did you know... Yellow Quill First Nation is a Saulteaux Nation located 12 kms east of Rose Valley, Sask. Chief Yellow-quill signed an adhesion to Treaty 4 on August 24, 1876. There are approximately 2800 members who live on and off reserve. In March 2011, over 16,000 acres of Treaty Land Entitlement (TLE) lands were converted to reserve status by Canada. TLE land refers to land that was promised in Treaty 4 but never received by the Nation. Yellow Quill Bison Ranch ([yqfn.ca/yellow-quill-first-nation/projects/](http://yqfn.ca/yellow-quill-first-nation/projects/)) is owned and operated by the Yellow Quill First Nation.

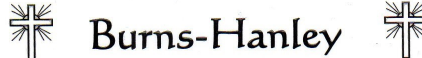

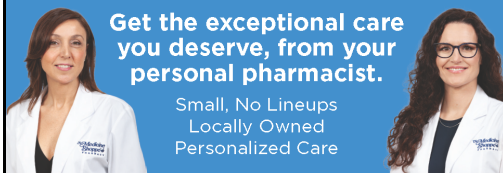
