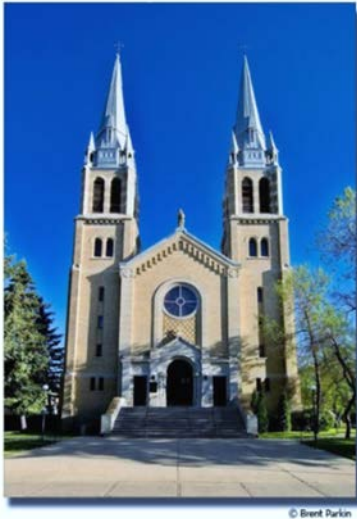

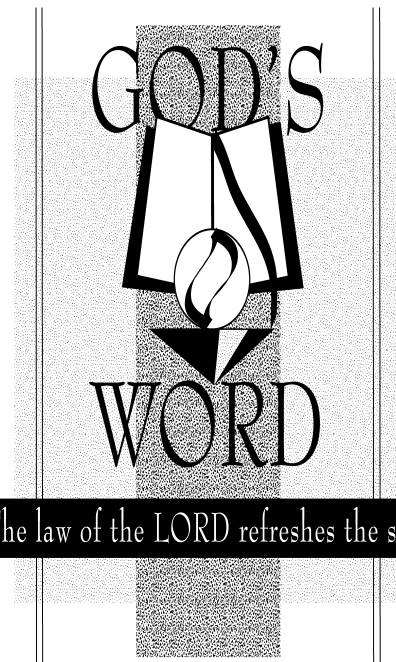

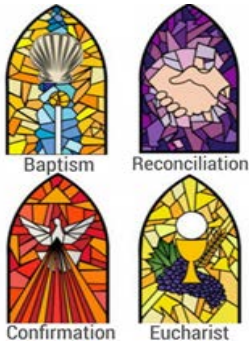
## HRC Choir Rehearsal

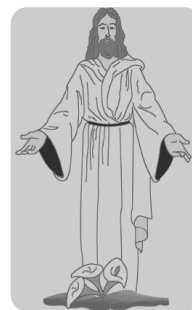
