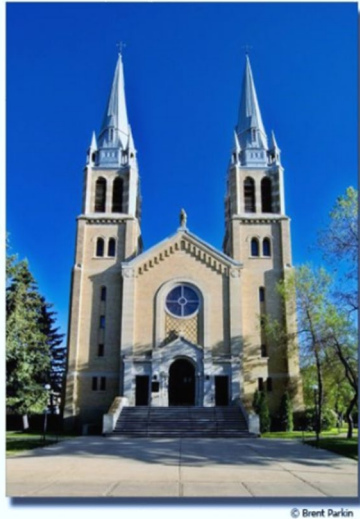

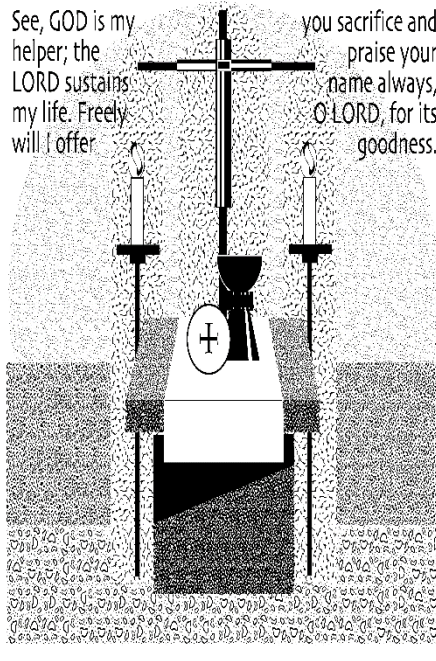

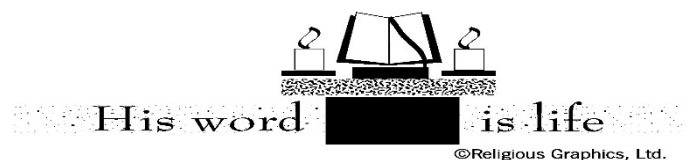

... **social connection** (i.e., practicing English, workshops on common social challenges/interests, etc.)

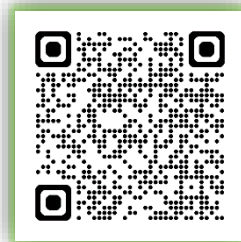
... **opportunities to connect with outside organizations** to support community needs (i.e. policing community outreach, etc.)

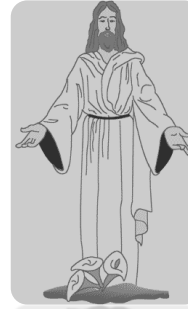

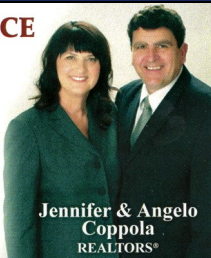
