

"They all ate and were satisfied. And when the leftover fragments were picked up, they filled twelve wicker baskets." (Luke 9.17) The story of the Loaves and Fishes shows us that when we share what we have,

Today <u>at 4 p.m.</u>, Maxine Thevenot will present an organ recital here at Holy Rosary. The program will include music by Cesar Franck, J.S. Bach and local composer David McIntyre among others. This week, Maxine completed the recording stage of what will be the first ever professional recording of our McGuigan Organ. During the coming months, the recording will go through the production process: the takes will be woven together through the digital editing process to create intermediate edits and a final master CD. The CD booklet and artwork will be created, edited, proofread and made ready for the printers. Finally, the whole package will go to the record company who will send it to the CD production plant to be pressed. Every stage of a project of this type costs money, so if you would like to help bring a little piece of Saskatchewan (and Holy Rosary Cathedral) to a wider audience, your support would be welcomed. 
